

About Soweto & NieuwLand

Soweto is not a traditional landlord, but a housing association with roots in the squatters' movement. It is based on principles of tenant responsibility, participation, self-organization and solidarity.

Users of the workspaces, living group and public space together constitute the building association, that is responsible for the administration, upkeep and renovation of the building. The association meets monthly, and is organized horizontally around several working groups or commissions, such as finances, maintenance, communications, etc.

The chosen model in the NieuwLand is: low rent + high level of DIY (do-it-yourself)! So we don't have a housekeeper, but we clean the toilets ourselves. We DIY almost everything, therefore we need tenants to be able to commit time to the communal tasks.

The NieuwLand community consists of workspaces, a living group and the public space:

- Workspaces: other tenants of workspaces are a Kung Fu and Lion dance studio for children; De Fietskliniek, a collective bicycle repairing/recycling workshop; and a book keeper helping ZZP-ers and people with debts.
- The 'Woehoe' living group, consisting of 11 people and Dante the cat
- The public space called 'NieuwLand' is a non-commercial, social and political space run by volunteers only. The space is used by activist groups like climate activists and housing activists. But in the space you can also find a choir singing, clothes swaps, queer activities, film screenings, benefit events and more!!

Tenants of the workspaces are also active as volunteer in the public space, for example by organizing public events.
